### A guide of the programme for one, two or a multiple of weeks - *Living and Learning*

- We create an environment in which our guests can learn, practise and listen to Italian in the little town of Agnone, where there are really no tourists. Good Italian is spoken and there are many things to do; cultural, culinary and recreational, in a beautiful natural and unspoilt landscape.
- The teachers are all experienced and qualified to teach Italian to foreigners.
- The guides work carefully to make the visits clear and interesting, and at the right level of Italian for whichever group they are leading.
- The city has a rich tradition in artisan work going back centuries; guests will visit workshops and foundries and meet the masters of these crafts.
- The food is simple, seasonal and natural. We enjoy cooking with various homemakers, and eating with their families, while chatting together.
- Alto Molise produces excellent 'stretched curd cheeses'. Guests will have a chance to visit some of the local family run dairy farms.
- We will visit other small family businesses making salamis, sweets and pastries, wine, oil and honey.
- Discover this region, very tied to its traditions, as you study the language.

- A2, B1, B2: from early intermediate to advanced.
